Eleanor Strotz is an Analyst with the firm Freeman & Mills, a consulting firm offering services in the areas of accounting, finance, economics and business practices and procedures.

Ms. Strotz's experience includes financial statement analysis, economic modeling, data analysis, and proficiency in software applications.
